The EfM program is preparation for the ministry to which we all are called. It is that vocation for which we pray at the end of the Eucharist: "And now, Father, send us out to do the work you have given us to do, to love and serve you as faithful witnesses of Christ our Lord."

Our seminar is guided by 3 mentors, Bridget Hyde, Terry Jolliffe, and J'Lynn Wheeler through four years of study: **Year One, The Hebrew Bible, Year Two: The New Testament, Year Three: Church History and Year Four: Theology, Ethics, and Interfaith Encounter.** Through discussion and guided reflection, the seminars furnish an opportunity to deepen understanding of the reading materials.

On Tuesday, August 25, 6-8:30 pm Parlor, First Presbyterian Church we will meet for an orientation, get acquainted time and registration. Not sure yet? Pick up the first lesson's materials on the 25th, come back on Tuesday, September 1, and try a class--no obligation.

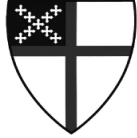
