Jubilee Center of Midland Walk for Hunger

Jubilee Center of Midland is sponsoring its second annual Walk for the Hungry. Participants may choose to walk/run/bike/swim or any physical event where progress can be measured. This event runs from March 7, 2016-May 7, 2016. There are various ways to participate:

Pick up a form from the table in the Parish Hall and enlist sponsors. Record your miles, and collect donations from sponsors at the conclusion of the event. Participants will then give donors a provided receipt for their support.

Sign the poster in the Parish Hall with your name, goal for miles per week, and mileage completed each week. There is a space for sponsors where supporters may sign to sponsor you. This gives everyone the opportunity to participate. Sponsors/Donors will be given a receipt for their support at the conclusion of the event.

St. Nicholas is also sponsoring a **5k-10k Walk/Run Event May 7th at Midland College**. Registration begins at 1:00p.m., and the race begins at 2:00 p.m. Awards and medal ceremony will follow the event, and miles completed go toward Walk for Hunger miles for participants. Entry fees are \$15.00 for 5k, and \$20.00 for 10 k.
